Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the group with any EMAP board member”

As a member of **EMAP**, you are expected to abide by the following code of practice:

- All members must take responsibility in ensuring they are up to date with the rules, understand and adhere to them.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Members should recognise the valuable contribution made by coaches, instructors and officials.
- All members must respect officials and publicly accept their decisions.
- All members should be a positive role model, treat each other and officials with the same level of respect you would expect to be shown to you.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- Bullying of any sort will not be tolerated.
- Encourage everyone to enjoy martial Arts and understand that people have different motivations for taking part.
